What about your shrink?

FLORENCE My shrink never has an opinion.
DAVID So you decided all by yourself?
FLORENCE Well, I kind of think I'm the one in the best position to make that decision.
DAVID It's a big decision.
FLORENCE I was never a serious case anyway.
DAVID You seem better since you started taking them, though.
FLORENCE Yeah.
DAVID So then why would you stop?
FLORENCE (shrugging: for her, that's evidence that she should stop) So so I can feel more. So I can drink.
DAVID You don't drink.
FLORENCE Not much.
DAVID Still.
FLORENCE Maybe I'd have more of a sex drive, also.

FLORENCE Do you not want me to have more of a sex drive?

DAVID

You have an 11-year-old son. I'm just saying.

FLORENCE

I am not going to kill myself! I'm just tired of... of...

(she searches, then finds the word, and

is happy)

Of being beige. I wasn't beige, before.

DAVID

You were a fuckin roller coaster.

FLORENCE

A roller coaster isn't boring.

DAVID

We fought all the time.

FLORENCE

It wasn't just me. It was you, too.

DAVID

Yeah. But we're good now.

FLORENCE

Because I give in even when you're wrong, because I don't care.

DAVID

Well that's just it: do you want to be right, in life, or do you want to be happy?

FLORENCE

I wanna be right.
